## Language Arts

Free reading book: As part of the school's ongoing effort to promote literacy, students need to bring a free reading book in case they finish an assignment early. Regular homework assignments may be given using books on the school's Accelerated Reader test list. Pocket folders: Students may be asked to bring a pocket folder to store special projects. Keep a few at home.

## COMPUTER:

### **Computer Lab**

**Earphones:** Computers in the lab will take the standard earphones used in CD players. An inexpensive set should be labeled and kept in the student's locker. Younger students may bring them in labeled, zippered plastic bags for storage at school. For hygienic reasons, earphones are not provided in the lab.

**Microphone:** 7th and 8th grade students using PowerPoint may wish to bring microphones for use in creating sound files for presentations.

**USB FLASH DRIVE (DATA STICK):** Students may wish to transfer work between home and school using a USB Flash drive. The most inexpensive drive you can find will have more than enough room for all school work created during a school year. Students in grades K-6 should check with their classroom teacher before making this purchase.

**Operating System:** We are running Windows XP Pro in the Computer Lab. Productivity software: Microsoft Office 2003.
